It is possible to book a room in the hotel "Haus Heege" (www.hausheege.de) as participant or supervisor. The booking can only be made via registration. Attention: The amount of rooms is limited!

Pitches for mobile homes or caravans are available in the parking lot at the Hyndai Turowski car dealer. Camping with a tent is not possible on site.

Each participant and supervisor will receive 1x breakfast in the hotel or in the catering area at the start/finish. Breakfast is included in the starting fee. In the catering area, lunch and dinner can be purchased at your own expense.

Rules, liability, data collection:

The IKSA RULES apply.

In addition, the following applies:

Criterium: The first two rows of the starting grid will be set up on the result of the European Championship. The organizer can change the order due to the current performance of the athletes.

Long Race: The first two rows of the starting grid will be set up on the result of the European Championship. The organizer can change the order due to the current performance of the athletes.

Relay: The organizer reserves the right to race in A-Relay and B-Relay due to current performance to split the athletes.

For the German Footbike Championship:

Joint start according to category, separate evaluation. The title "German Champion" can only be awarded to persons with German citizenship. There will be a separate award ceremony.

Participants under the age of 18 require written consent from a legal guardian. This must be presented when the starting documents are issued.

The race results will be published 15 minutes after the last participant has crossed the finish line.

Protest against the race result can be filed within 30 minutes after publication for a fee of €20.00. It must be lodged towards the chairman of the jury. If the protest is justified, the fee will be reimbursed.

The organizer reserves the right to change the length of the route due to the amount of registrations in each category or difficult weather conditions.

The participant is obliged to wear a protective helmet during the race.

Participation in the event takes place in accordance with the competition regulations and organizational guidelines and race announcement and at your own risk. The organizer assumes no liability for health risks of the participant in connection with participation in the event.

The participant is given advice to have appropriate health, accident and liability insurance with necessary coverage by himself, including loss of his personal coverage.

The organizer's liability - also towards third parties - is limited to intent and wilful negligence. This is also valid for the companies and helpers provided by the organizer. The liability of the organizer for other damages like injury to life, body or health is excluded unless it is intentional or wilful negligent breach of duty by the organizer or his deputy or vicarious agent.

The organizer is not liable for equipment and other items that are lost during the event, if there is no wilful breach of duty by the organizer. Therefore participant should be insured against theft.

The participant declares in a binding manner that there are no health concerns by participating in the event.

The participant is obliged to familiarize himself with the competition routes, the access roads and other required locations and accept them in the conditions as they currently are. He bears all risks arising themselves.

The personal data provided by the participant in the registration will be stored and used for processing and execution of the event.

The participant agrees that the data provided in the registration are stored and shard for timekeeping, ranking and results and may be published in connection with photos Film recordings and interviews without any claim for remuneration. This release also covers cooperation and advertising partners of the organizer.

By registration each participant accepts these conditions.

Attachment of start no. and chip

The participant must attach the start no. to the handlebars of the footbike so that it is clearly visible. The proper attachment will be checked by the jury. If the start no. Is applied incorrectly, results may not be detected completly and this may lead to disqualification from the race.

The chip for timing must be attached to the front wheel fork of the footbike above the quick release. Proper attachment will be checked by the jury. If the chip is not attached correctly, results maynot be recorded completly and this may result in disqualification from the race.

AFTER THE RACE, THE START NUMBER AND THE CHIP MUST BE RETURNED TO THE ISSUMINGOFFICE.
